




Our High School

There are two options: University and High Technician.



Before University

- > To join at the University Spanish students have to pass an important exam called PAU.
- The mark of the PAU and the marks of Bachillerato are going to show what degree can you study.

Foreign students are exempt from taking this

exam.

The University

The purpose of the University is for prepare students for laboral world and to guarantee the knowledge in specific areas



If you are older than 25 you can do an specific exam to join

Grades

- The areas which are studies in University are called: Grades
- > It's the first part spanish high studies
- In that part students must know the basic knowledges in different areas (Science, Art...)

Post-grade

- The second part called post-grade is composed by:
- Master (Prepare students for a specific job)
- Doctor (Profesional specialist in investigation of concret areas)

High Training Programs

- This training provides knowledge that allows the different jobs to be carried out autonomously.
- The professional modules focus on two courses.
 - The degree obtained is the Higher Technician of the profession in the cycle studied.

You don't need PAU, it depends on your marks.
